

# Sinatra tribute due an encore in Shores

*A Tribute to Sinatra & Friends* — a musical showcasing the work of the late Frank Sinatra — is coming back for an encore performance at the Shores Performing Arts Theater.

The event will raise money for the theater and for hurricane victims in Central America.

The show will be at 2 and 8 p.m. Jan. 16 at the Shores Theater, 9806 NE Second Ave. Tickets are \$12.

The performance will feature Larry Branchetti, who has a style and voice similar to Sina-

tra's. Branchetti, who also has blue eyes, will sing 15 classic Sinatra songs, including *The Lady is a Tramp*, *My Way* and *New York, New York*.

Joining Branchetti on stage will be Pat Sapia and Alden McKay who will do impressions of Tony Bennett, Sammy Davis Jr., Dean Martin, Mel Torme, Peter Lawford and Joey Bishop.

Lucky Syms will join the group with her impersonation of Liza Minnelli.

The show, which debuted in July, was also scheduled for a

performance in September but was postponed because of Hurricane Georges. This time around, audiences can expect more songs, dance routines and new dialogue.

"We need the support to get this money to these people," Branchetti said. "I think we are going to have a good show. All the music has been changed around. It will be a different show."
